CONDITIONS

- 1 Entries close on 27 September 2006 - DRAW WILL BE MADE AT 7PM THIS DATE IS FINAL
- 2 Each competitor must fill in a separate entry form. No entry will be accepted unless in writing and accompanied by the appropriate entry fee. No entry will be accepted for a doubles event unless entry forms and appropriate fees are received from both players. Each competitor must be available at the time stated in the programme unless they receive prior exemption from the Hon Referee, and must also report to the Hon Referee on arrival and before changing.
- 3 Any competitor who is without a partner for any doubles event and wants to be included in that event should write 'partner required' in the appropriate space on the entry
- 4 Competitors must be members of a club affiliated to the B.A. of E and eligible & available when selected to represent Durham County (see Handbook for Rules & Regulations.)
- 5 Suitable badminton clothing only will be allowed on the courts during play. The wearing of tracksuits will only be allowed during 'knocking up'.
- 6 The Committee reserves the right to refuse entries without assigning any reason; to add or alter these conditions; and to withhold or reduce the prizes if entries are deemed to be insufficient. The Committee's decision in all matters will be final.
- 7 All Challenge Trophies are to be held by the winners for one year.
- 8 Cheques should be made payable to: 'The Durham County Badminton Association'.
- 9 The Tournament will be run in accordance with the Regulations for Tournaments as published in the Badminton Association of England Handbook.
- 10 Yehlex shuttles will be used.
